#### Past Ministry in Thailand

Our first 4 years in Thailand consisted of one year at language school, then 3 years working alongside a couple of senior OMF church planting missionaries. These past 5 years we have been planting a church in the city of Suphanburi, 100 km northwest of Bangkok. In 2007, after 4 difficult years, a church started to emerge. Now about 20 believers meet on a Sunday.



#### Future Ministry in Thailand

In January 2009 we return to Thailand for another 4-year term with OMF. God willing we will use the current church as a springboard to plant another church in a neighbouring city in Suphanburi province.
